Since the program requires a master's degree for admission, there is no provision for transfer of master's level coursework into the doctoral program. Students who have completed doctoral level coursework at a regionally accredited institution may petition for transfer of up to eighteen semester credits, subject to the recommendation of the Program Director and the approval of the Dean. Transfer credits may not have been used as part of a conferred graduate degree, and must be completed with a grade of "B" or higher.

Program Costs

Tuition is \$870 per credit for 2019-20. Students are required to take 28 credits the first year. The number of credits required decreases in each of the subsequent four years (26, 18, 12, and 3 credits respectively) for a total estimated tuition of \$75,690.
